*** We work with knives. This placement is not suitable for people with issues of violence.**

Please review the items below with your group **before** you come to work at the Gleaners.

Leaders:

- 1/ Group leaders are responsible for submitting a list of all group members along with contact and medical information in case of emergency.
- 2/ If there are any members of the group with special needs, please notify the manager prior to your scheduled work day. gleanersmanager@sympatico.ca

Leaders and Group:

- 1/ Closed-toe shoes must be worn.
- 2/ Please bring some snacks to share at break time.
- 3/ Group leaders are responsible for overseeing their group. The manager or assistant will work with the leader who is to make sure that the group follows all instructions.
- 4/ Groups are encouraged to mix in with the other volunteers at break time. We find this enhances the overall experience of their work morning.
- 5/ Some placements may involve working with water. A change of clothing, socks and extra footwear is recommended.
- 6/ At the end of your morning, please assist with clean-up. Washing pails, tipping compost and cleaning floors are especially appreciated.
- 7/ Please use caution as we have various pieces of equipment and wet floors can be slippery.

What to Expect:

- Tour: At some point, your group will be toured through the building with an opportunity to ask questions about the operation.
- Name tags: We all work on a first name basis. Please ensure that everyone fills out a nametag upon arrival.
- Coffee Break: Occasionally we hear from a missions group who has used our soup in a relief or development effort.
- Regular volunteers: Endeavour to help host your group so your overall experience will be meaningful.
