Gleaners Mix Aides Zimbabwe During Emergency Drought

As I write this, I want to bless you (the reader and faithful supporter of *Ontario Christian Gleaners*), just as I was blessed and encouraged by 1 Chronicles 29 verses 12 and 13, where it says: "*Both riches and honour come from you, and you rule overall. In your hand are power and might, and in your hand, it is to make great and to give strength to all. And now we thank you, our God, and praise your glorious name*".

2024 turned out to be a very tough year for the Zimbabwean people. A nation (of 16M people) already beset with economic woes (24.9% Inflation, volatility in exchange rate, a 9% unemployment rate), and added to this there was little or no rainfall, the country was declared a 'drought emergency'. This was the worst drought Zimbabwe had experienced in 40 years. The drought impacted almost one half of the nation's population, leading millions of people to seek emergency food support. Globally, Zimbabwe took the second place with Namibia for the countries worst affected by drought and famine (source: www.statista.com). To quote a local village pastor on receiving the July 2024 shipment of vegetable soup mix (from the *Gleaners*): "*I have never seen people this happy today. They are grateful for the timely intervention. Things are not well. Hunger is real here. Please thank the generous donors for their timely help*".

On a macro level, organizations like *UNICEF* responded with food aid to the most affected districts. This was far from enough to feed a starving nation!



On a local level, in and around the areas served by the *Karanda Mission Hospital* (where the *Gleaners* donations are being distributed), the response was to schedule all-night prayer meetings to cry out to the Lord for help. And the Lord answered! Temporal relief came in through timely cash donations from generous Southern Ontario supporters. This allowed the Hospital Community development team to buy and stockpile large quantities of maize flour for distribution in the villages and schools in the area. Relief came in from the *Ontario Christian Gleaners*, who graciously supplied an extra container of vegetable soup mix, as they were blessed with an abundant supply in the summer.

This container was loaded and shipped in December 2024. It is expected to reach the village in March 2025. Praise the Lord! Then the Lord opened up the heavens! In the months of December and early January, the area was blessed with rainfall!

This allowed the people to plant sustenance crops – maize, cowpeas and ground nut (peanut). These would be harvested in March/April 2025.

We join the writer of 1 Chronicles and say: We thank you, our God, and praise your glorious name! Thank you *Ontario Christian Gleaners* for being used by our God to bless brothers and sisters in Zimbabwe!
